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3 This Court having reviewed the Motions and pleadings on file, having heard
4 testimony from witnesses and argument from counsel for both parties and having
5 reviewed the applicable law, finds that the basis for issuing a preliminary injunction has
6 not been demonstrated. The hearing that Plaintiffs have asked this Court to enjoin is
7 clearly within the authority of the administrative agency to conduct under state law.
8 NRS 388A.330 (3). The court will not insert itself into the proceedings until the
9 administrative agency has made a determination at its hearing. Thus, the issues raised
10 in Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction are not ripe.

11 The court further declines to rule on the Motion to Dismiss in this matter, holding
12 it in abeyance at this time.

13 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Restraining
14 Order/ Preliminary Injunction is **DENIED**.


