Increased Rigor: Democracy Prep provides scholars with comprehensive and rigorous college preparation including extensive literacy and math instruction

More Instructional Time: Scholars attend class for at least eight hours each day for over 185 days each year and are offered additional Saturday and summer academies for additional support

<u>Data Driven Decision Making:</u> We use frequent data collection and analysis to drive instruction and ensure efficient use of resource





<u>Authentic Civic Engagement:</u> Civic education is mandatory at Democracy Prep. We believe all schools should be preparing student should be preparing citizens in our democracy



<u>All student in all subjects:</u> DPPS actively recruits students at risk of academic failure — including those with ELL classifications, IEPs, and 504 plans — and consistently enrolls students in high-need subgroups in numbers greater than or equal to those of zoned public schools located in the surrounding districts.



<u>Public Funds:</u> We believe our core programs should be sustainable using public funds to demonstrate what is possible in public education. Democracy Prep Public Schools is 100% funded by per pupil spending, rejecting the need to raise funds and instead focusing on what is important: educating scholars.


- Reading Proficiency = 42%
