

Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF)




NSPF

- Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) December 2015
 - States are tasked with to create accountability system to ensure that "meaningfully differentiate" schools based on:
 - Academic Proficiency on State assessments;
 - Graduation rates for high school;
 - English Language Proficiency;
 - Growth or other State-wide academic indicator for K-8 schools;
 - At least one other State-determined indicators of school quality or student success; and
 - 95% assessment participation rate.





Elementary School Performance Framework





Middle School Performance Framework






