







Compared to overall enrollment, what is the race/ethnicity of students (i.e., students without disabilities and IDFA students) receiving disciplinary actions?











#### Race/Ethnicity of IDEA Students Receiving Disciplinary Actions

Compared to IDEA enrollment, what is the race/ethnicity of IDEA students receiving disciplinary actions?




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







## 3-Year English Language Arts Proficiency Trend (3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade)





## 2-Year Math Proficiency Trend (11th Grade)





## 2-Year English Language Arts Proficiency Trend (11th Grade)


SPCSA 2-Year Trend: ACT ELA Proficiency


