- Students will complete a practice test when they first login. They will have access to two additional practice tests to complete at a later date.
- Based on their practice test performance, students will be assigned lessons and videos to reinforce concepts.

#### 11th Graders

- All 11<sup>th</sup> graders were invited to attend an ACT Boot Camp session on February 13<sup>th</sup>.
- ► We had 50 participants.
- Students were sent materials prior to the Boot Camp session that they used throughout the session and can utilize up until their ACT exam.

- 4. Ongoing review of academic and financial data
