Dear SPCSA Board Members,

Eagle NV is seeking a good cause exemption to submit an RFA summarizing how services, initially proposed to be provided by a CMO, will instead be managed and provided by the local Governing Board and Eagle NV staff. Submission of this documentation has been requested from the SPCSA Board during your November meeting, and the narrative within the RFA has been specifically drafted to address requests from the SPCSA staff.

Our model, mission, and vision of Eagle NV are intentionally designed to meet the needs of at-risk students who attend low performing schools in Clark County. In recent months, the Governing Board of Eagle Nevada has secured an appropriate facility, been granted a Special Use Permit, identified our founding principal, and connected with over 150 additional interested families.

While we recognize that not engaging with a CMO is change from our initial charter application, we are confident that the Eagle Nevada team has the knowledge and resources to fulfill our charter commitment and provide a tremendously high-quality education to the students who will attend our Sahara campus in the Fall.

We appreciate your time and attention to this matter. The Eagle Nevada team is looking forward to expanding further as to how we will continue to be dynamic as we constantly evaluate performance and improve our model to best serve students and families.
