NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption of Regulations of the State Public Charter School Authority

The State Public Charter School Authority will hold a public hearing at 2:05 P.M. on November 4, 2016 to be video conference in the Board Room at the Nevada Department of Education Offices, 700 East Fifth Street Carson City Nevada and 9890 South Maryland Parkway, Las Vegas, Nevada.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoptions of regulations of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 388A. The time for the hearing is scheduled as follows:

2:05 P.M. The proposed regulation, R088-16, adds new language to Chapter 388A of NAC. It requires that a charter school sponsored by the State Public Charter School Authority use a unique identifier to identify itself and use a unique identified for any campus of a charter school. The regulation also provides that each such charter school shall maintain and report certain data to the State Public Charter School Authority both as aggregate data for the charter school as a whole and separately for each campus of the charter school in a format that allows for both the evaluation of each campus of the charter school and the charter school as a whole.

NOTE: Possible action to adopt may be taken at this meeting. The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

- 1. The need and the purpose of the proposed regulations/amendments.
- SB509, codified in NRS 388A, permits the State Public Charter School Authority to adopt regulations establishing requirements concerning the manner in which it reports data including, without limitation, the manner in which data must be aggregated or disaggregated in any report.
- 2. Either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved.

The proposed regulation requires that a charter school sponsored by the State Public Charter School Authority will use a unique identifier to identify itself and use a unique identified for any campus of a charter school. The regulation also provides for each such charter school shall maintain and report certain data to the State Public Charter School Authority both as aggregate data for the charter school as a whole and separately for each campus of the charter school in a format that allows for both the evaluation of each campus of the charter school and the charter school as a whole.

- 3. There is no economic effect of the regulation on the business that it regulates and no impact on the public.
 - a. There are neither adverse nor beneficial effects.
 - b. There are no immediate or long term effects.
- 4. There is no cost to the agency for the enforcement of the proposed regulation.
- 5. There is no duplication or overlap of regulations of state or local government agencies.
- 6. This regulation is not required pursuant to federal law
- 7. The proposed regulation does not include provisions that are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity.
- 8. The proposed regulation does not establish a new fee or increases an existing fee of the State Public Charter School Authority.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the State Public Charter School Authority may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data,

views or arguments, in written form, to the State Public Charter School Authority, 1749 North Stewart Street, Carson City, NV 89706. Written submissions must be received by the State Public Charter School Authority on or before October 28, 2016. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the State Public Charter School Authority may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

A copy of this notice and the regulation to be adopted will be on file at the State Library and Archives, 100 Stewart Street, Suite 40, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and the regulation to be amended/adopted/repealed will be available at the State Public Charter School Authority, 1749 North Stewart Street, Suite 40, Carson, City, NV 80706 and in all counties in which an office of the agency is not maintained, at the main public library, for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours. This notice and the text of the proposed regulation are also available in the State of Nevada Register of Administrative Regulations, which is prepared and published monthly by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS 233B.0653 and on the Internet at http://www.leg.state.nv.us. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies, if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
