Recently, Quest Charter School's elementary and middle school programs received ratings under the Nevada School Performance Framework for the 2017-2018 school year. This is the first year during which individual campuses received ratings and unique school codes. Quest's Northwest campus's elementary and middle school programs received three and two stars respectively, while Quest's Bridger campus's elementary school program received two stars.


This memorandum is meant to provide the Authority Board with background related to Quest's elementary and middle school programs, and as a supplement to Mr. Kern's Receiver Report. Attached to this memorandum is a chart showing the historical performance of Quest's elementary and middle school programs under the NSPF.

Elementary School


For reference, Quest's elementary school was rated as a two-star school for the 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 school years (with an index score of 71), and a two-star school for the 2016-2017 school year (with an index score of 19). The two elementary school campuses each received their own rating for the 2017-2018 school year: Northwest's elementary school was designated as a three-star school (with an index score of 48.5) while the (closed) Bridger campus's elementary school was designated as a two-star school (with an index score of 47).

Middle School

Quest's middle school was rated as a three-star school for the 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 school years (with an index score of 61), and a two-star school for the 2016-2017 school year (with an index score of 33.5). For the 2017-2018 school year, Quest's middle school received a three-star rating (with an index score of 56). It should be noted that this score represents an increase of 22.5 index points over the preceding year.
