

NSPF

- Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) – December 2015
 - States are tasked with to create accountability system to ensure that “meaningfully differentiate” schools based on:
 - Academic Proficiency on State assessments;
 - Graduation rates for high school;
 - English Language Proficiency;
 - Growth or other State-wide academic indicator for K-8 schools;
 - At least one other State-determined indicators of school quality or student success; and
 - 95% assessment participation rate.





Elementary School Performance Framework





Middle School Performance Framework





HIGH SCHOOL


High School Performance Framework

Charters, Campuses, & NSPF Star Ratings

This year SPCSA will receive total of 102 star ratings- one for each elementary, middle and high school


Examples

- Pinecrest Academy has one (1) charter, four (4) campuses, eight (8) star ratings- one for each elementary, middle and high school.
- Oasis Academy has one (1) charter, one (1) campus, three (3) ratings - one elementary, one middle, and one high school.

SPCSA Academic Performance Framework




Nevada School Performance Framework - Star rating - 60 pts
