Mrs. Wilbourne stated a family survey was sent inviting families to describe one word answers that defined our school and mission. Staff met and repeated activity and held a work session to generate the statement: All Discover, All Are Welcome, All Grow to Succeed. Families were given the opportunity to revisit the statement after the staff met. President Carrie Buck made a motion to approve. Member Stinnett seconded the motion and the Board voted unanimously to approve.
