Re: Request for Good Cause Exemption from Amendment Cycle

Executive Director Feiden:

SLAM Academy of Nevada (SLAM) requests a good faith exemption from the current amendment cycle to amend their charter contract with the SPCSA to add a dual-credit program as required by NRS 389.310.

In an effort to comply with the language in NRS 389.310, which was added to the law through Senate Bill 19 in the 2017 Legislative Session, SLAM has recently executed a cooperative agreement with the College of Southern Nevada (CSN) to provide dual credit courses to a small group of approved students attending SLAM. SLAM currently plans on enrolling its first students into the dual-credit program commencing with the second semester of the 2020/2021 school year. Now, in order to comply with the Nevada State Public Charter School Authority's requirements SLAM seeks this good faith exemption to the application cycle.

As the deadline for Letters of Intent to submit requests for amendments has passed, we are asking that an exemption be granted and that the application to add a dual-credit program be heard as soon as possible to allow students to enroll in dual-credit courses in the second semester.
