

GEMS' PLACEMENT EFFORTS

Student and Staff Plans for SY '23 - '24

STUDENT PLACEMENT EFFORTS

- Multiple communications home regarding GEMS' board meetings, votes for closure, outcome, and plans to help students find schools for next year.
- Young Women's Leadership Academy (YWLA) has come to campus 7 times, including all day at GEMS School Choice Fair on 5/4 to provide information to families, answer questions, and assist with registration.
- YWLA also hosted 40 students for a Shadow Day experience on May 8.
- Other schools, including TEACHLV, SNTHS, and NV Rise have come to campus to offer information and support to families.

STUDENT PLACEMENT RESULTS

- 88 Students Enrolled at GEMS as of 5/17
- Family Survey was sent home last week, staff followed up this week to collect as many responses as possible
- We inquired about families' plans for the next school year:
 - 14 No response to inquiry
 - 7 Unsure of future plans
 - 67 Have certain plans for next year
 - 26 have enrolled or plan to enroll at YWLA
 - Most others plan to return to CCSD (Orr, Woodbury, Del Sol, Valley, etc.)

STAFF PLACEMENT EFFORTS

- Multiple meetings and communications with staff regarding GEMS' board meetings, votes for closure, outcome, and plans to help staff find jobs for next year.
- YWLA and TEACHLV administration made arrangements to observe teachers and discuss potential employment based on each schools' needs.
- GEMS administration have had one on one conversations with staff regarding future plans and needed support

STAFF PLACEMENT RESULTS

- 14 Staff (13 full time and 1 part time) at GEMS as of 5/17
- Staff survey was sent out two weeks ago for initial understanding of staff's plans, one-on-one discussions have been ongoing
- Plans for next year
 - 1 part time employee & 1 teacher have plans to leave education per previous career goals
 - 1 teacher is retiring (after 57 years!)
 - 1 teacher is debating about retiring
 - 4 staff members have secured employment
 - 6 staff members are actively seeking employment in education
 - Administrators have been working to connect these individuals with potential employers, including YWLA & TEACHLV, and have offered follow up support as needed, including letters of recommendation, references, advice, networking, etc.
