Due to clarification as provided when pursing the Nevada Charter Schools Program grant, this addendum reflects a change in enrollment policy to reflect closer alignment with Nevada laws and regulations, and conformity with Charter Schools Program Title V, Part B of the ESEA Nonregulatory Guidance, Section E-3 regarding weighted lotteries.

Lottery Exemptions

- Siblings of currently enrolled students
- Children of current staff members at Futuro Academy

Currently, the state of Nevada does not explicitly legally allow weighted lotteries. Futuro Academy intends to follow all Nevada regulations and laws regarding lotteries and admission. Per our stated mission and vision, and due to the demographics in the

proposed site, Futuro Academy seeks to work with these following sub-groups of students to reflect the demographics of the proposed site, and to fulfill the greatest predicted educational needs of our student population:

- 1. Students who are at risk as defined as English Language Learners and who reside within two (2) miles of Futuro Academy
- 2. Students who at-risk as defined as economically disadvantaged and who reside within two (2) miles of Futuro Academy
- 3. Students residing within two (2) miles of Futuro Academy's location
- 4. Students residing Clark County School District who are at risk as defined as English Language Learners
- 5. Students residing in Clark County School District who at-risk as defined as economically disadvantaged
- 6. Students residing in Clark County School District
- 7. Students residing in the state of Nevada outside of Clark County

This set of priorities is a guiding principle for ensuring that in our recruiting and marketing plans, Futuro Academy engages with all populations to reflect the needs of the community it will serve. Should regulations or legislation be enacted to allow for weighted lottery preference hierarchy, the list above directly reflects the priority of Futuro Academy to serve students who are English Language Learners and economically disadvantaged and to reflect the demographics of East Las Vegas where Futuro Academy intends to be located, and which is in alignment with the federal Charter Schools Program Title V, Part B of the ESEA Nonregulatory Guidance, section E-3 "Weighted Lotteries".

Futuro Academy will have an open enrollment period followed by a lottery during the following situations:

- Approaching our first year of operation (Incubation Year 2016-17)
- For annual enrollment in lowest grade, or vacancies in other grades below the target enrollment.
