Since I've noticed there's clearly an agenda from the Charter school Admins and some parents, trying to evoke feelings- Here are some facts:

1. By the CDC's estimate, 40% of people with Covid-19 show no symptoms. Monitoring temperatures and symptoms isn't going to cut it. Staff and families are not going to get tested without experiencing symptoms.

2. In Kentucky, where the governor has long cautioned that infections were climbing quickly, he said Tuesday that "every day, things appear to be getting worse."

"We are seeing not only a surge in the virus, but more and more of our kids by percentage who are getting it," Gov. Andy Beshear said.

3. (CNN) Soaring case counts around the country are impacting children at "unprecedented levels," according to new numbers released Monday by the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Children's Hospital Association, which are tracking data reported by state health departments. There were 61,000 new cases in children during the last week of October, "which is larger than any previous week in the pandemic," the AAP said in a statement. From the onset of the pandemic through October 29, more than 853,000 children have tested positive for Covid-19, the AAP said, **including nearly 200,000 new cases during the month of October**.

4. The White House Coronavirus Task Force and Harvard Global Health Institute recommends Clark County NV Schools: Enable remote learning for all students. All government levels should invest in remote learning.
