- Current enrollment 1093 students and numbers continue to grow each week.

  - 10<sup>th</sup> Grade 392 students

# **Academic Achievement**

- First ACT Boot Camp of the year held on September 25<sup>th</sup>.
  - 43 students attended virtually
  - $\circ~$  3 more Boot Camps will be held this school year.
- ACT preparation has been incorporated into all courses, to maintain consistency and lessen confusion.
- Literacy Specialist is continuing to work with students identified as performing in the 10<sup>th</sup> percentile or below.
- Math Interventionist is conducting small group lessons, tutoring and support based on student needs.
- Curriculum and instruction will be modified to promote critical thinking skills.
- Grading Framework created and implemented to ensure that all grading is consistent, accurate, meaningful and supportive of student learning.



### **Star 360 Benchmark Testing Results**

• First round took place during the first two weeks of September.

- 95% completion for both ELA and Math
- Second round will be held when students return from Winter Break in January

### **ACT Alignment**

- o 11<sup>th</sup> Graders: 12.4% projected to be proficient in Math
- 11<sup>th</sup> Graders: 50% projected to be proficient in ELA

## **College & Career Readiness**

- $\circ$   $\,$  3 Tracks for students to choose from:
  - Track 1: AP/Honors
    - 8 in-house AP courses taught by AP certified teachers (all attended AP summer institute)
    - Creation of AP Coordinator role and AP Academy to support high expectations and achievement
      - AP Academy Agreement signed by both student and Caretaker agreeing to expectations.
      - Regular AP Academy meetings held with students.
  - Track 2: CTE Pathways
    - Health Science
    - $\circ$  Marketing
    - o Business
    - Hospitality and Tourism
  - Track 3: Dual Enrollment through TMCC
    - Increased the number of Dual Enrollment course offerings through TMCC including: Sign Language, Drawing, Art Appreciation, Fundamentals of College Math, Critical Thinking and Reasoning and quite a few more!

# Student Engagement

- o School Mascot chosen!
  - o NCA Bears!
  - Mascot will be named by families & staff.
- Grade Level Academies
  - Grade level teachers met twice per month at the start of the year to discuss ways to increase student engagement.
    - $\circ$   $\,$  Virtual field trips are being held
    - Padlet is being utilized to learn more about student interests
    - Grade level communication is sent regularly to connect with students.
- 7 different processes in place to support student success.
  Processes include academic, behavioral and social and emotional learning support.
- Truancy Diversion Program
  - Partnering with the Eighth Judicial District Court to help reduce chronic absenteeism.
  - Supports students and their families to address students' school attendance, behavior and grades.
