Facilities

Young Women's Leadership Academy considers how facilities support the mission and vision of our school. Our learning environment supports our model implementation through aligned furniture, fixtures, and expenditures. Additionally, we have included a few building preparation points below.

- The Planning Committee has approved our Special Use Permit.
- Public Works has approved.
- Traffic Study supports a safe ingress and egress for daily arrival and dismissal.
- Engineering consultants have completed a review of mechanical and fire suppression systems. The necessary improvements for our facility are aligned with our budgeted Tenant Improvements.
- The lease is being finalized with edits/comments exchanged
- Our Religious Insignia Documentation is being drafted.
