

May 2023 Southern Nevada Trades High School Update

Facility

Our General Contractor began demolition under a demo permit on Phase A (the 8 classrooms) the week of May 2nd. We received our building permit for this phase on May 11th, but it did not include the correct plans. Our architect is working with the county to remedy, and the revised permit should be approved before the GC moves on from demo. We are on target for occupying on July 7th.

Staffing

We have hired 5 teachers including Social Studies, ELA, SPED, Elective Wheel, and a FLEX teacher. We have pending offers for CTE, Science, and Math. We have also hired our Counselor.

Students

We have 109 applications and 38 enrollments (14 completed and 24 missing documents). We continue to work closely with Latino Outreach Solutions to table at events as well as canvas. We are hosting an enrollment event at our campus on June 3rd with free food trucks and games and will advertise the event on local media. Press releases have been sent and we are planning radio ads on Spanish radio and additional advertising including digital.

Finances

To date, our team has raised \$939,600.00 in unrestricted donations. We received a grant for \$109,000 from the Commission on Construction. We also received the Opportunity 180 Year Zero grant for \$100,000. This brings our restricted funding total to \$1,709,000 and total raised to \$2,648,600.
