Subject: Important Update Regarding DBAE's Opening

Dear Melissa,

I hope this message finds you well.

After careful consideration, the leadership team and board of Do & Be Arts Academy of Excellence (DBAE) have decided to postpone our opening until the 2025/2026 school year. This decision follows the recent news that Rooted School Las Vegas will defer its opening until next year, and their building will not be ready until September 9th.

We would also like to formally request the withdrawal of our amendment application regarding a temporary location change for the 2024/2025 school year and recommend the SPCSA's board approve our deferral. Although the DBAE board has not had the opportunity to meet and officially vote on this decision, they are all aware of the current circumstances and will officially meet on July 31st to vote to defer.

We understand the impact of this delay and are actively working with other charter school leaders to secure placements for our staff for the 2024/2025 school year. We will also be notifying families of our decision and connecting them with nearby charter schools that are similar to our educational model.

This delay does not change our commitment to our mission. We aim to be a four or five-star school, dedicated to offering the highest quality educational experience for our students and staff. It's important for us to take the necessary time to ensure that everyone feels comfortable and confident in our space before we open. We will keep families engaged and expect to officially announce our building by October. We will also host arts-related events throughout the year to stay connected with past students and attract new enrollments.
