# What does each framework measure?

## Academic

- Is the educational program a success?

## Financial

- Is the school financially viable?

## Organizational

- Is the organization effective and well run?

# Organizational Framework Principles

1	Enable SPCSA to fulfill its <b>mission</b> as authorizer and regulator
2	Fulfill <b>NRS 388A.273 requirements</b> for performance indicators, measures and metrics for the <b>organization</b> category
3	Fulfill public school <b>obligations</b> , provide <b>transparent reporting</b>
4	Convey SPCSA <b>expectations</b> of charter schools
5	<b>Streamline work</b> for staff and schools

# Organizational Framework: Areas of Focus

1	Education Program	Adherence to the material terms of its program and the responsibility to serve all students	20
2	Financial Management and Oversight	Audit completion, results and audit findings	20
3	Governance and Reporting	Board compliance with governance-related laws	20
4	Students and Employees	Adherence to state and federal laws and regulations	20
5	School Environment	Compliance with facility, transportation, food and health service requirements	20

# Ratings

## Meets Standards

- Schools earning this rating are performing well and are generally compliant.
- The targets for this rating category set the minimum expectations for charter school performance.

## Does Not Meet Standards

- Schools in this rating category failed to meet minimum expectations.
- At a minimum, they should be subject to closer monitoring, and their status for renewal is in question.

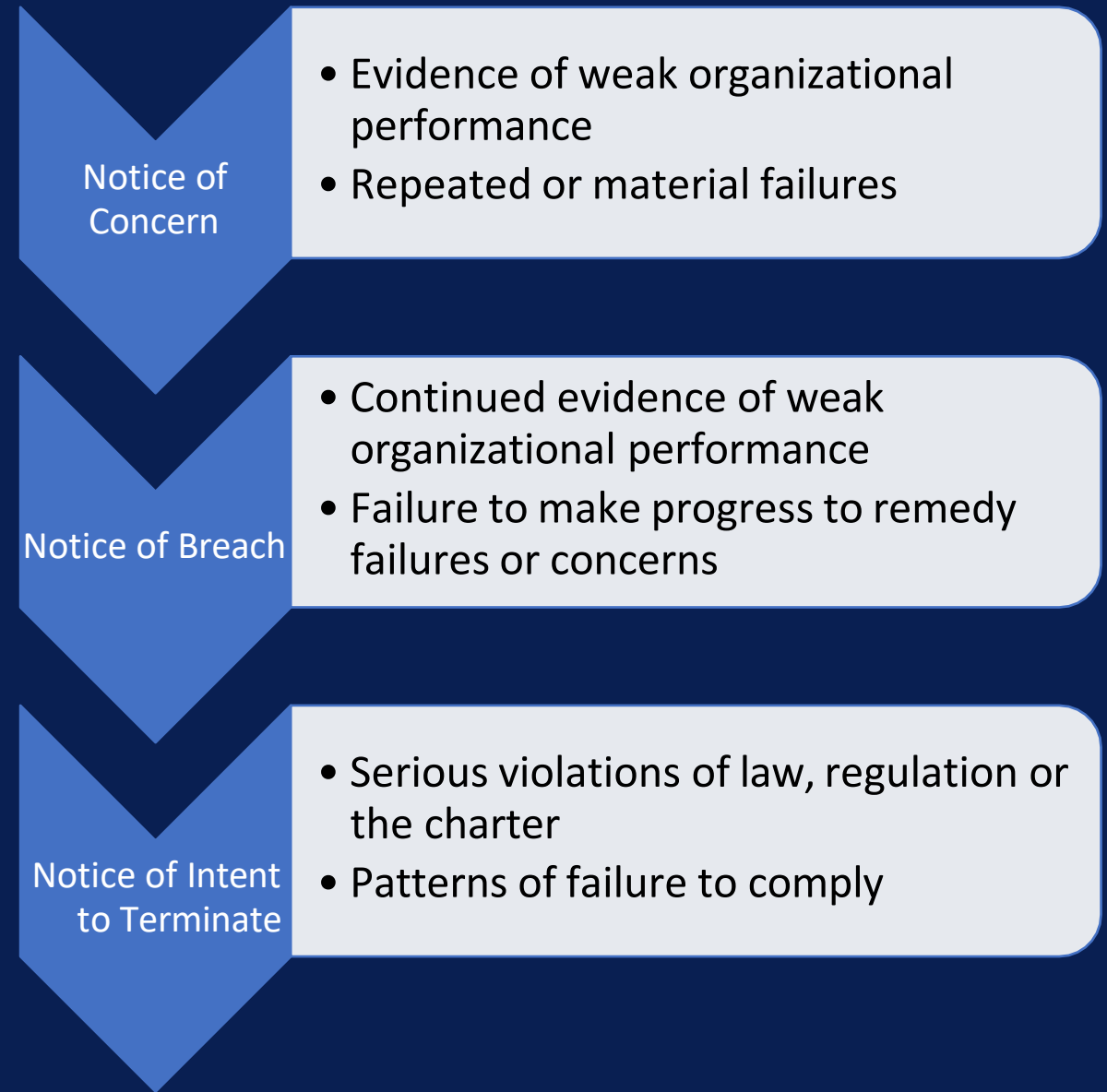
- All schools, but for five, earned at least 80 points out of a possible 100 in SYE24.

# Interventions

“Occasionally, the routine Performance Framework process will result in adverse findings. Charter schools may fall out of **compliance on important legal or contractual requirements.** Academic standards may not be met. Financial sustainability may become an issue. When these situations occur, the Authority may respond in a number of ways.”

Due to the structure of the newly approved Organizational Performance Framework, SPCSA staff are not recommending issuing Notices to any of the schools who received 79 points or fewer and received an overall rating of Does Not Meet Standards, as listed below:
