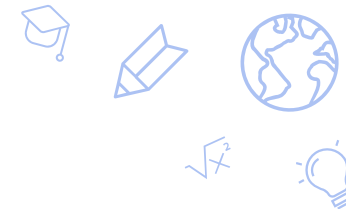

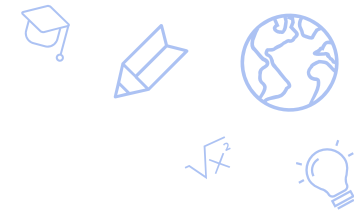

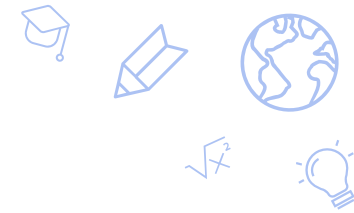
# School Information

- Grade level(s)
  - Serving Grades K-8
  - Elementary (grades 3-5) rated 1-star
  - Middle School rated 4-star, almost 5-star
- Majority-minority population, 52% Hispanic/Latino
- 11% Special Education, 16% English Language Learners
- 53% Free & Reduced Lunch, Title I



# Academic Goal(s)

- 70% of students will meet their projected growth in Math and Reading from the Fall 2024 MAP Assessment to the Spring 2025 MAP Assessment
- 50% of Freedom Classical Academy's SPED students will achieve a minimum of 61 percentile for growth in Math or Reading from the Fall 2024 to the Spring 2025 MAP test.



# Measurable Action Steps

- Change school schedule to allow for teacher departmentalization in grades 3-5.
- Provide pull-out intervention groups to struggling students
- Hire an EL Interventionist to provide small-group support to EL Students. Purchase EL – specific intervention curriculum.
- Provide academic competitions including Golden Sentinels, Reading Challenge, Multiplication Challenge, and Spelling Bee to incentivize student engagement in learning activities
- Host a “Parent University” to help parents understand our math program.
