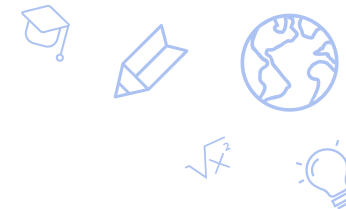

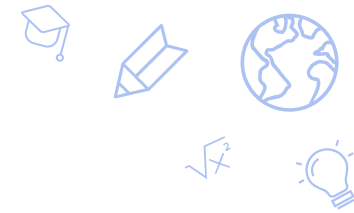
School Information

 - 5th highest performance of all Washoe County Title 1 Elementary Schools



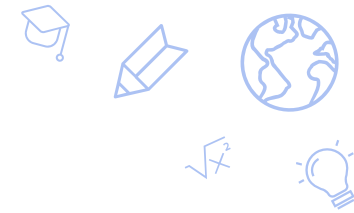
Academic Goal

- Elementary Goal: By the end of the 24/25 school, Mater will increase the following proficiency rates, as measured by SBAC:
 - ELA--from 35.7% to 48%* Math--from 43.7% to 55% * Science--from 8.3% to 18%
- Middle School Goal: By the end of the 24/25 school year, Mater will increase the following proficiency rates, as measured by SBAC:
 - *ELA--from 30.9% to 46% *Math--from 26.9%-40% *Science--from 36.5% to 45%
- First goal in our School Performance Plan for both Elementary and Middle School.



Measurable Action Steps-Reading

- Science of Reading—PD and Instructional Shifts
 - Systematic and explicit instruction through a curriculum that is used with integrity and provides regular assessments and data for K-2
 - Text Centered Comprehension Work for 3-8th grade
 - On-going throughout the school year
 - We have had two whole school, full day Science of Reading PD and then have continued with weekly grade level specific PD
 - We are evaluating the effectiveness of these shifts through teacher surveys, classroom observations and student achievement shifts



Measurable Action Steps-Math

- Math—PD and Instructional Shifts
 - Building conceptual understanding aligned with SBAC Claims and Data for 3rd-8th grade
 - On-going throughout the school year
 - Math Cohort PD started in September through RPDP monthly and then have continued with weekly grade level specific PD
 - We are evaluating the effectiveness of these shifts through teacher surveys, classroom observations and student achievement shifts.
