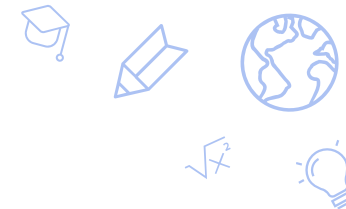

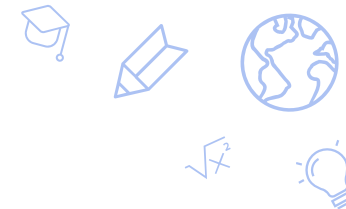
School Information

- Grade K-12
 - SLAM Nevada is a comprehensive K-12 charter school
 - SLAM Nevada K-5 is rated a 2 star, 41 points

- SLAM serves a diverse population:

9.6% White	12.8% Black/African American	60.2% Hispanic/Latino
3.3% Asian	3.2% Pacific Islander	10.8% Two or more

- Other relevant characteristics or information
 - SLAM increased 21 index points ranking in the top 5% increase for all ES in Nevada
 - SLAM ES does not have any flags for ATSI



Academic Goal(s)

School Performance Plan Student Success Goal:

- Increase the percentage of all students proficient in ELA from 33.9% Spring 2024 to 45% Spring 2025 as measured by SBAC.
- Increase the percentage of all student proficiency in Math from 34.6% in Spring 2024 to 45% in Spring 2025 as measured by SBAC.



Measurable Action Steps

- Tightened Instruction
 - To ensure all instruction provides the rigor necessary for students to succeed, SLAM Elementary adopted SAVVAS, MyView, as a new reading curriculum.
 - Provide targeted support from admin, coaches, and grade level leads for any teachers who are struggling with Tier 1 and Tier 2 instruction in ELA and/or Math.
 - Adopted Open SciEd science curriculum to provide higher rigor science instruction K-5.
- Inspect Data
 - Review student data regularly utilizing iReady reports and summative assessments in ELA and Math.
- Respond to Data
 - Ensure students are being taught targeted skills that fit their needs based on data from iReady and other reliable sources.
 - Increase number of staff pulling students for targeted instruction.
 - Increase number of minutes students receive targeted instruction.
