School Highlight

The SPCSA site visit team has completed site visits at all six of the former CCSD charter schools, now in the SPCSA portfolio. We want to highlight one of those schools, Odyssey Charter School. Odyssey Charter School serves 2391 students from K-12. One of the major bright spots for Odyssey is its strong performance on the Nevada School Performance Framework. Both the middle and elementary schools are showing impressive results, with the middle school earning a five-star rating and an index score of 84.5 out of 100. The elementary school also performed very well, receiving a four-star rating with a score of 76.1. What really stands out is that both schools earned a perfect 10 out of 10 on the Closing Opportunity Gaps Indicator in English Language Arts, showing the school's commitment to supporting all students and helping them grow.

Another strength is Odyssey's expanding Career and Technical Education program. The school currently offers pathways in graphic design and cybersecurity, giving students hands-on experience in high-demand fields. Even more exciting, Odyssey is preparing to introduce a video game design pathway in the near future, creating additional opportunities for students to explore creative and technical career interests.
