19 The court has jurisdiction over the parties and this matter, and it appears to the  
20 satisfaction of the Court that the Adverse Party has committed and/or is committing and/or  
21 remains a threat to commit harassment in the workplace, and an Extended Order is warranted.

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1 **ADVERSE PARTY, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

2 **YOU ARE ORDERED**, either directly or through an agent, to not intimidate, use, attempt  
3 to use, or threaten the use of physical force, or otherwise interfere in any way with the  
4 employer, an employee of the employer while the employee is performing his duties of  
5 employment, and any person while the person is present at the workplace of the employer,  
6 including all employees.

7 **YOU ARE ORDERED**, to not contact at all in any way, including but not limited to in  
8 person, by phone/text, by email, or social media the employer, employee of the employer while  
9 the employee is performing duties of employment, and any person while the person is present  
10 at the workplace of the employer.

11 **YOU ARE ORDERED** to stay 100 feet away from the workplace of the employer,  
12 wherever situated within the State, including, but not limited to, the following specific  
13 workplace address(es):

22 for protection order shall be transmitted forthwith together with the verified Application and  
23 supporting Affidavit, to the applicable Sheriff's Office, or Constable, who will promptly  
24 attempt to serve the same upon the Adverse Party, and upon service, file return of service form  
25 with the court.

1 **VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CRIME**

2 **This is an official court order. If you disobey this order, you may be arrested and**  
3 **prosecuted for the crime of violating an order for protection against harassment in**  
4 **the workplace and any other crime that you may have committed in disobeying this**  
5 **order.** You can be arrested even if the person who obtained this Order invites or allows  
6 you to contact him or her. You have the sole responsibility to avoid or refrain from  
violating the terms of this Order. A violation includes but is not limited to contact in the  
form of verbal, electronic, and social media communications.


7 **You are further notified of the penalty for violation of an order. A person who**  
8 **intentionally violates** an Extended Order for Protection Against Harassment in the  
9 Workplace is guilty of a misdemeanor, unless a more severe penalty is prescribed by law  
10 for the act that constitutes the violation of the Order. (NRS 33.350.) A misdemeanor is  
11 punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for up to 6 months, and/or by a fine of not  
12 more than \$1,000.00. (NRS 193.150.) If the act that constitutes the violation of a  
protection order is itself a felony, the violator shall, in addition to the term of  
imprisonment prescribed by statute for the crime, be punished by imprisonment in the  
state prison for a minimum term of not less than 1 year and a maximum term of not more  
than 20 years. (NRS193.166.)

13 **Only the court can change this order.**

14  
15 **ORDER TO LAW ENFORCEMENT**

16 Any law enforcement officer, with or without a warrant, may arrest and take into  
17 custody the Adverse Party, when the law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe that  
18 (a) an Order has been issued pursuant to NRS 33.270 against the Adverse Party; (b) the  
19 Adverse Party has been served with a copy of the Order; and (c) the Adverse Party is acting or  
20 has acted in violation of the Order. This arrest may occur regardless of whether the violation  
21 occurred in the officer's presence. Any law enforcement agency in this state may enforce a  
22 Court Order issued pursuant to NRS 33.270 without regard to the county in which the Order is  
23 issued.
