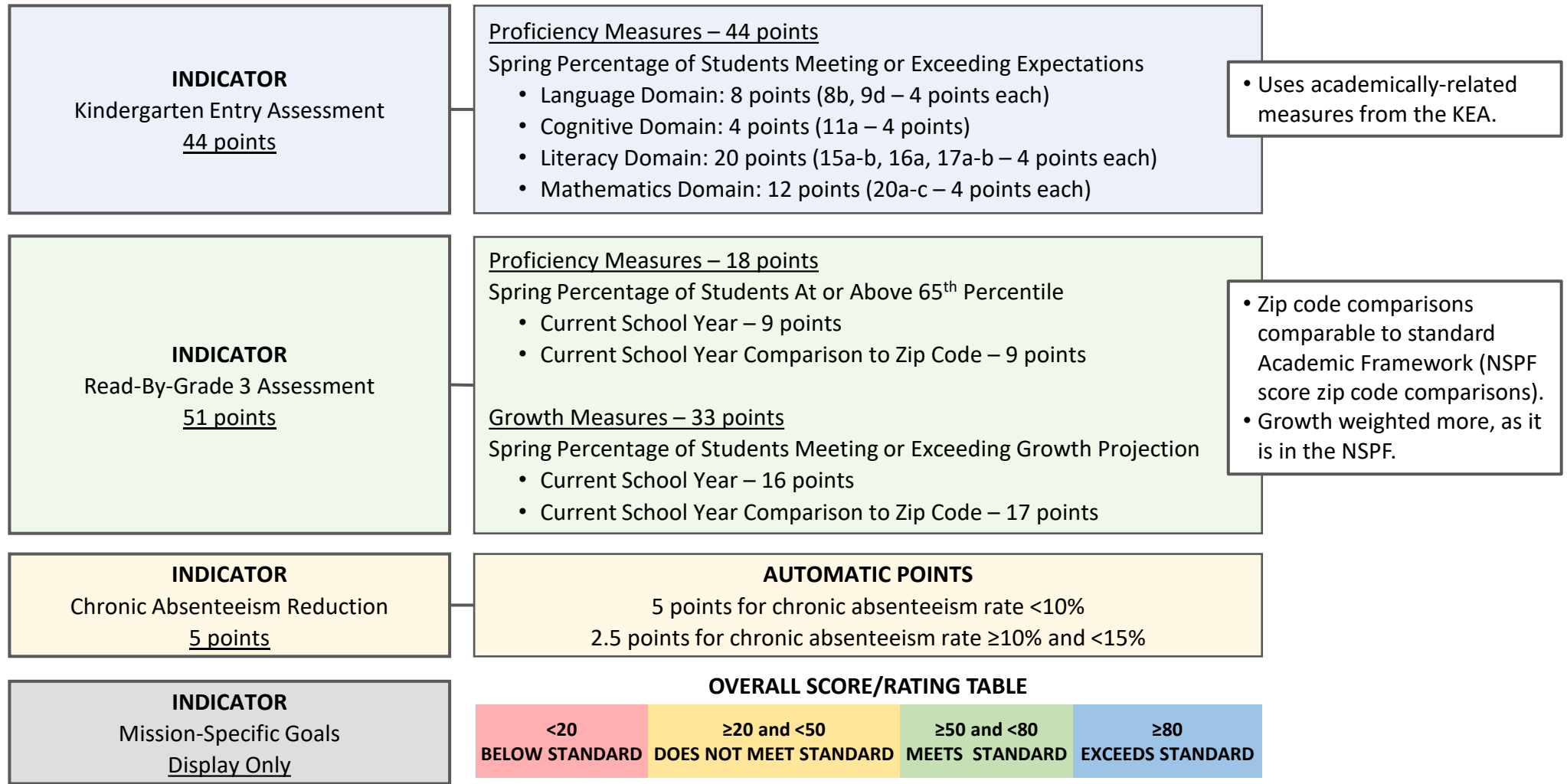


# Academic Performance Framework Revisions: Purpose



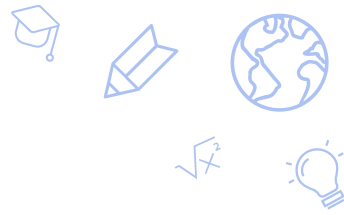
- Nevada Revised Statute ([NRS 388A.273](#)) requires charter school sponsors like the SPCSA to include academic, financial, and organizational performance frameworks in charter contracts. Accordingly, the SPCSA has adopted the SPCSA [Academic](#), [Financial](#), and [Organizational](#) Performance Frameworks.
- To receive an SPCSA Academic Framework rating, an SPCSA school must first receive a Nevada School Performance Framework (NSPF) star rating. Certain SPCSA schools that serve only early childhood grades (K, 1, 2, and/or 3) do not receive an NSPF rating due to a lack of grade 3-8 state assessment proficiency and/or growth data and therefore do not receive an SPCSA Academic Framework rating.
- When an SPCSA school does not have NSPF or SPCSA Academic Framework rating data, it is difficult for the SPCSA to evaluate its academic performance for the purposes of authorizing decisions such as charter contract amendments, renewals, etc.
- Therefore, SPCSA staff propose an addendum to the standard SPCSA Academic Framework, where such schools are subject to an SPCSA K-3 Academic Framework, described as follows.
  - This proposed K-3 Academic Framework would use data available for and specific to K-3 grade levels.
  - In drafting this proposal, SPCSA staff incorporated feedback from relevant charter school leaders/staff as well as the Nevada Department of Education Office of Early Learning and Development.
