- **Relocate to a New Facility – Springs Campus**
- **Increase Enrollment Cap – Springs Campus**

DATE: November 14, 2025

Summary of Request and Recommendation

Pinecrest Academy of Nevada (PAN) has submitted an amendment application requesting that the State Public Charter School Authority (SPCSA) grant a Good Cause Exemption and approve the request to relocate the Springs campus and to increase the enrollment cap for the Springs campus.

SPCSA staff has reviewed the application and recommends that the Authority grant the Good Cause Exemption and approve the amendment request. A proposed motion along can be found on page 3 of this memo.

Background and Overview of the Amendment

The SPCSA approved the expansion of the PAN network to open the Springs campus at its October 7, 2022 board meeting. The Springs campus opened in August 2023 in temporary location at 6151 West Charleston Blvd. Las Vegas, 89146. PAN Springs campus currently serves grades K-5 and had 266 students enrolled in grades K-4 according to the 2024 Validation Day. According to the amendment application, PAN notes that while this temporary site allowed Springs to open and begin serving students, its limited classroom space constrained enrollment and hindered the school's ability to meet community demand and realize the full vision outlined in the original amendment application.

PAN was able to find and secure a permanent facility for the Springs campus at 2850 South Lindell Road, Las Vegas NV, 89146, which is the same zip code the permanent facility is located in. According to the amendment application, the proposed new site, a 47,489-square-foot facility situated on 6.09 acres and formerly home to the Lied Memorial Boys & Girls Club, provides ample space to expand both

elementary and middle school programs and will enable the school to serve the number of students that the expansion of the Springs campus originally intended.

In addition to the move to the new, permanent facility, PAN is requesting an increase to the approved enrollment cap for the Springs campus. When the Springs campus was approved by the SPCSA in 2022, the school was approved to open its school serving 645 students and would have been approved to serve 1080 students for the 2026-27 school year. Due to the setbacks with the originally planned facility, the Springs campus opened serving considerably fewer students and with few grade level offerings. With the move to the permanent facility, Pan is requesting the Springs campus be approved to serve 681 students at the start of the 2026-27 school year. Currently, the Springs campus is approved to serve 421 students. PAN Springs was also approved to serve grades K-12 in its original charter amendment application and has been adding a grade level each year since opening with grades K-3.

If approved, the PAN Springs enrollment cap will be:

Regarding the facility itself, PAN explained in the amendment application that proposed permanent facility is in the same zip code as the school's existing facility and remains within one of the five target zip codes (89102, 89106, 89107, 89108, and 89146) outlined in the school's original charter amendment application. Additionally, the facility features 36 classrooms, which will accommodate enrollment growth to 681 students in the 2026-27 school year, providing ample instructional space for core academics, specials, and enrichment programs. Dedicated student laboratories will support STEM instruction, while a multipurpose room and cafeteria/kitchen will enhance both the academic program and daily operations. The facility will have a capacity of approximately 900 students, the new site will not only accommodate the projected enrollment increase but also provide flexibility for future programming needs.

According to the amendment application, Pan will assume full ownership of the new facility and will work with XL Charter Development to ensure the school is ready for a 2026-27 opening. Additionally according to the school, XL Charter will cover all upfront costs associated with developing the property, including legal fees for acquisition and entitlement, earnest money deposit, due diligence studies (such as Alta survey, traffic study, asbestos, Phase 1 environmental assessment, etc.), architectural design, and permit application fees. At closing, PAN will reimburse XL Charter for the associated project costs incurred before closing. Finally, according to the amendment application, PAN intends to fund facility-related costs through a combination of available reserves, per-pupil revenue, and, if necessary, long-term financing secured through its development partners.

Legal Authority

Existing charter schools that are sponsored by the SPCSA may submit a charter school contract amendment application to the SPCSA – which is reviewed by SPCSA staff and presented for SPCSA Board action – to, among other things, increase enrollment, add grade levels above and beyond what the charter school is approved to serve, or add a new campus. When determining whether to approve an amendment request, the sponsor considers the charter school's compliance with applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations and evidence relating to the academics, finance and organization of the

charter school.¹

Analysis and Staff Recommendation

When reviewing an amendment application for RFA eligibility, SPCSA staff reviews the academic, financial and organizational performance of the applicant charter school. In the case of PAN, SPCSA staff finds the school to be meeting academic, financial and organizational performance expectations for all campuses. Additionally, the Springs campus received its first rating during the 2024-25 school year and the elementary school was rated as 5-stars under the NSPF. The elementary, middle, and high school programs across the PAN network are operating at 4 and 5-star levels under the NSPF ratings for the 2024-25 school year, and either met or exceeded standards according to the 2023-2024 SPCSA Academic Performance results. Specific campus academic ratings are included on pages 8 - 12 of this memo.

Additionally, the PAN earned an In Compliance rating under the SPCSA Organizational Performance Framework for the 2024 – 25 school year as approved by the Authority on October 10, 2025. As such, SPCSA staff finds the school to be Meeting Standards. PAN has also been found to ‘Meet the Standards’ on the most recent 2024 SPCSA Financial Performance Framework.

Regarding the amendment request, SPCSA staff is recommending approval. PAN Springs was originally approved to serve many more students than the temporary facility was able to hold, and this request to move into a permanent facility will succeed in meeting the expectations of the Authority when the campus was approved in 2022. As noted above, the new facility will be in the same zip code as the temporary facility is located and the school still intends to serve the zip codes that were originally approved as part of the initial amendment application. One item staff would note is the continued expansion of grade levels beyond K-8 which was also approved in 2022. While not part of this amendment request, staff of both the school and EMO have been in touch with SPCSA staff about finding a facility that will ultimately hold the high school when the Springs campus grows into those grade bands. As such, the enrollment cap for the Springs campus may increase in coming years based on the search for the additional facility, but that potential expansion does not have an impact on the amendment the school is currently requesting.

Proposed Motion: Grant the Good Cause Exemption request and approve Pinecrest Academy of Nevada’s requests to: increase the enrollment cap at the Springs campus and relocate the Springs campus to 2850 South Lindell Road, Las Vegas NV, 89146 with the following condition:

- **That the school complete the SPSCA pre-opening process for new schools and campuses for occupation of the new facility space for the Springs campus.**
