Notice of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption of Regulations of the State Public Charter School Authority as proposed in LCB File #R080-24.

The State Public Charter School Authority will hold a public hearing at **9:00AM on Friday**, **November 14, 2025**, at the **Nevada State Legislature**, **Room #165 at 7230 Amigo Street**, **Las Vegas**, **NV 89119**. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the amendment of regulations pertaining to 388A.010, 388A.250, 388A.255, 388A.260, 388A.410, 388A.415, and 388A.680 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 233B.0603:

1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment:

Streamline and clarify the processes of the State Public Charter School Authority.

2. If the proposed regulation is a permanent regulation, a statement explaining how to obtain the approved or revised text of the proposed regulation prepared by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS 233B.063:

The revised text of the proposed regulation is attached to this notice.

3. Description of the proposed regulation, or the subjects and issues involved:

This regulation reorganizes certain provisions relating to the process for the State Public Charter School Authority to approve an application to form a charter school or request to amend a charter contract. Additionally, it revises the terms for which the Authority may renew a charter contract. It repeals authority for the Executive Director of the Authority to develop an abbreviated application to form a charter school and repeals provisions relating to the use of certain gifts, grants, bequests, or donations.

4. Estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public:

There is no economic effect of the regulation on the business that it regulates and no impact on the public.

5. Method used by the agency in determining the impact on a small business:

Small business is not impacted by this regulation.

6. Estimated cost to the agency for the enforcement of the proposed regulation:

There is no cost to the agency for the enforcement of this regulation.

7. Description and citation of the duplicative or overlapping regulations of other state or local governmental agencies:

There is no duplication or overlap of regulations of state or local governmental agencies.

8. Is the regulation required by federal law?

This regulation is not required by federal law.

9. Does the regulation include provisions more stringent that a federal regulation regarding the same activity?

There are no federal laws affecting or overlapping the proposed regulation.

10. Does the proposed regulation establish a new fee or increase an existing fee?

The proposed regulations do not establish a new fee nor increase an existing fee of the regulating agency.

A record of all submitted comments will be retained, and the SPCSA will proceed to consider any public comment received.
