SUBJECT: **Pinecrest Academy of Nevada– Charter Amendment Request to Increase Enrollment Cap – Virtual Campus**
DATE: March 13, 2026

Summary of Request and Recommendation

Pinecrest Academy of Nevada (PAN) has submitted an amendment application requesting that the State Public Charter School Authority (SPCSA) grant a Good Cause Exemption and approve the request to increase the enrollment cap for the Virtual campus.

SPCSA staff has reviewed the application and recommends that the Authority grant the Good Cause Exemption and approve the amendment request. A proposed motion can be found on page 3 of this memo.

Background and Overview of the Amendment

Pinecrest Academy’s Virtual campus opened in 2022 with an initial enrollment cap of 80 students in grades 6 – 10, which later increased to 170 students in grades 6 – 11 for the 2023 – 24 school year. Due to enrollment challenges, on May 17, 2024, the SPCSA approved a reduction in PAN Virtual’s enrollment cap to 135 students. The current enrollment cap for the Virtual campus, beginning in the 2024 – 25 school year, is 140 students. As of the 2025 Validation Day, PAN Virtual had 144 students enrolled in grades 6 – 12.

According to the amendment application, enrollment patterns have since shifted significantly at PAN Virtual. As of January 9, 2026, the Virtual campus has an active waitlist of 141 students. Additionally, PAN Virtual noted that this sustained demand demonstrated that the temporary cap reduction is no longer aligned with current interest, program capacity, or the needs of families seeking high-quality distance education. As such, PAN Virtual is requesting to amend its charter agreement to increase its enrollment cap from 140 to 182 students, beginning in the 2026 – 27 school year.

According to the amendment application, the school anticipates the benefits of the increase in

enrollment to extend to students, staff, and the broader school community. Students will benefit from expanded access to a high-quality virtual learning option, reduced waitlists, and increased opportunities for individualized academic support. Staff will benefit from greater program stability, sustainable staffing levels, and the ability to plan instruction and interventions based on predictable enrollment rather than constrained caps that no longer reflect reality.

If approved PAN Virtual explained they will implement the increase in two phases. Phase I of implementation from March through April 2026. During this period, the school will update its enrollment management and student information systems to reflect the revised enrollment cap, finalize internal planning assumptions, and prepare clear communication materials for families. PAN Virtual will also begin notifying families currently on the waitlist and open intent-to-enroll confirmations, allowing the school to accurately project enrollment levels and plan staffing and course sections accordingly. PAN Virtual expects this early engagement will ensure transparency with families and will enable PAN Virtual to align demand with available capacity well in advance of the academic year. Additionally, according to the amendment application, Phase II will occur from May through June 2026 and will focus on operational and instructional readiness. During this phase, the Registrar, counseling team, and instructional leadership will confirm student schedules, finalize course section assignments, and make any necessary staffing adjustments to support the increased enrollment. Staffing plans will be calibrated to preserve appropriate student-to-teacher ratios and ensure the continued delivery of individualized instruction, progress monitoring, and timely intervention supports.

If approved, the PAN Virtual enrollment cap will be:

Legal Authority

Existing charter schools that are sponsored by the SPCSA may submit a charter school contract amendment application to the SPCSA – which is reviewed by SPCSA staff and presented for SPCSA Board action – to, among other things, increase enrollment, add grade levels above and beyond what the charter school is approved to serve, or add a new campus. When determining whether to approve an amendment request, the sponsor considers the charter school’s compliance with applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations and evidence relating to the academics, finance and organization of the charter school.¹

Analysis and Staff Recommendation

When reviewing an amendment application for RFA eligibility, SPCSA staff reviews the academic, financial and organizational performance of the applicant charter school. In the case of PAN, SPCSA staff finds the school to be meeting academic, financial and organizational performance expectations for all campuses. Additionally, the Virtual campus has improved year-over-year since its initial opening year and was rated as 3-star for the middle school level in 2024 – 25. The elementary, middle, and high school programs across the PAN network operate at 3, 4 and 5-star levels under the NSPF ratings for the 2024-25 school year, and either met or exceeded standards according to the 2024-2025 SPCSA Academic Performance results. Specific campus academic ratings are included on pages 8 - 12 of this memo.

Additionally, the PAN earned an In Compliance rating under the SPCSA Organizational Performance Framework for the 2024 – 25 school year as approved by the Authority on October 10, 2025. As such, SPCSA staff finds the school to be Meeting Standards. PAN has also been found to ‘Meet the Standards’ on the most recent 2025 SPCSA Financial Performance Framework.

Regarding the amendment request, SPCSA staff is recommending approval. PAN Virtual was originally approved to serve a similar enrollment total when it was originally approved. After a few struggles in its opening year, the school has increased its enrollment while improving academic outcomes in the most recent two school years. The increase of 42 students to the overall cap is reasonable and the school provided adequate staffing plans and operational strategies to manage the modest increase.

Proposed Motion: Grant the Good Cause Exemption request and approve Pinecrest Academy of Nevada’s requests to increase the enrollment cap at the Virtual campus as detailed in the memo.
